



Vaccination Requirements for Grooming Guests

DHPPC (Distemper-Hepatitis-Parainfluenza-Parvo-Corona) – Yearly

Rabies – Every 3 years for adults – Same as Maricopa County requires

Bordatella IntraNasal - Yearly for Adults

The vaccination requirement for our grooming guests is based on our recommended Wellness program. It is what we and the AVMA (American Veterinary Medical Association) believe will provide optimal protection for your pet against disease. Vaccination not only protects your pet against disease but aids in the prevention of the spread of disease. To keep all our patients and grooming guests as healthy as possible we are asking for your cooperation in following this new policy. In the past year we have been experiencing an increased number of cases of kennel cough. The Bordetella vaccine protects against kennel cough. Historically we have only recommended this vaccine if we felt your dog was at risk of contracting this disease. We feel that our hospital is a clean environment and we do our best to sanitize immediately after every sick patient. However, we are a hospital, and if your pet comes in for a groom, your pet is at an increased risk of contracting disease. The best way to protect your pet against disease is to vaccinate.
